Book 17: Families with children

According to the results of 2011 Census of Population, Households and Dwellings, in the Republic of Serbia 1 there are 1 476 105 families with children, which makes 69.4% of the total number of families (2 125 772).

The most expressive are families with one child (every second family, i.e. 51.8% of the total number of families with children), followed by families with two children (40%), then come families with three (6.7%) and four children (1.1%). Families with five and more children are the least represented (0.4%).

In the Republic of Serbia an average family with children has 1.6 children.


Among families of the type married couple with children the share of families with one child (44.4%) is almost equal to the share of families with two children (46.3%). The share of families with three and more children equals 9.3%.

Among the families of the type consensual couple with children almost every second family has one child (48.8%), while 34.9% families have two children, and 16.3% families have three and more children.

On the other side, among lone parent families (mother/father with children) the most represented are families with one child (over 70%), followed by families with two children with the share of almost one quarter, while the share of families with three and more children is considerably lower than with couple families (below 4%).

Of the total number of children living with families, three quarters (74.4%) are aged below 25.

¹⁾ The 2011 Census was not conducted on the territory of the AP Kosovo and Metohia, while in the municipalities of Presevo and Bujanovac there was undercoverage of the census units owing to the boycott by most of the members of the Albanian ethnic community.

Families with children

Family is a community represented by a married or a consensual couple, or parents (both or one only) and their children. Here child means any persons, regardless the age and marital status, who lives with one parent or both parents and that in this household has no married/consensual partner or child.

The 2011 Census was carried out during the period from 1st to 15th October, 2011, in compliance with the Law on the Census of Population, Households and Dwellings ("The Official Gazette of the RS," no. 104/09 and 24/11). The Census is financially supported by the European Union which has participated in the total costs with 60%.
