Book 18: Main population sets

The book "Main population sets" presents a complex overview of the results of 2011 Census of population, households and dwellings on main characteristics of the population of the Republic of Serbia¹⁾ to the level of region:

Table 1 shows data on population by age and sex. The data on age are given in completed years of life (0, 1, 2,...,100+), and the data on infants below one year of age are given in completed months (0, 1,...,11).

In Table 2 presented are data on population aged 15 and over by year of birth, sex and legal marital status.

Table 3 presents data on population by ethnicity and mother tongue.

Table 4 comprises data on population by ethnicity and religion.

In Table 5 presented are data on population aged 15 and more by ethnicity, age, sex and educational attainment.

Table 6 contains data on population aged 15 and over by age, sex and school attended.

Table 7 contains data on total population by age, sex and economic activity.

In Table 8 offered are data on economically active population who performed occupation, by occupation and industry.



¹⁾ The 2011 Census was not conducted on the territory of the AP Kosovo and Metohia, while in the municipalities of Presevo and Bujanovac there was undercoverage of the census units owing to the boycott by most of the members of the Albanian ethnic community.
